Scott is a recently retired partner with PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC) where he spent over 31 years in various roles including Office Managing Partner and engagement partner over public and private companies in many industries. His career involved providing audit and business advisory services, has been involved in numerous complex filings with the SEC and has been instrumental in resolving unique accounting issues with the SEC on behalf of his clients.

In 2007, Scott returned from a four-year assignment in São Paulo, Brazil where he represented the Global firm of PwC to the 18 member firms in South and Central America and led the implementation of the Sarbanes-Oxley requirements in those countries. He had oversight responsibility for regulatory and risk management related matters in addition to functioning as the client service partner for many large multi-national clients with reporting requirements in the United States, in addition to functioning as the final reviewer for over a dozen PwC Foreign Private Issuers in Brazil, Argentina and Chile. Scott is fully fluent (written and verbal) in Portuguese.

In his last three years with PwC, Scott also directed reviews for PwC Global over compliance with PCAOB requirements for foreign firms located in China, Singapore, Brazil, Sweden, U.E.A. and Angola.
