Deborah Bayle recently retired as President and CEO of United Way of Salt Lake (UWSL), a position she held for 16 years. Her tenure at United Way culminated a 39-year career of serving our community.

At UWSL, she was a catalyst for positive change. She led UWSL through a dramatic, ten-year transformation of its vision, mission and business model, which made UWSL a national model for results-driven community change.

Deborah is a recognized expert on leadership, management, change management, strategic planning, governance and accountability, social issues, women's issues and the nonprofit sector.

Prior to her appointment as President and CEO of UWSL, she served as CEO for the Greater Salt Lake Area Chapter of the American Red Cross for three years. From 1976 to 1996, she was on the staff of the Salt Lake Area Chamber of Commerce, where she rose to the position of Chief Operating Officer.

Deborah is very active in community affairs. She currently serves as a member of the Board of Directors of People's Utah Bancorporation (PUB), the holding company for People's Intermountain Bank and its divisions, Bank of American Fork and Lewiston State Bank. In her role with PUB, she serves on the Audit Committee and the Nominating/Governance Committee.

She serves as a member of the Boards of Directors of St. Mark's Hospital, Susan G. Komen Utah, the University of Utah College of Fine Arts, the National Association of Corporate Directors Utah Chapter, and the Utah Golf Foundation. She is a member of the Executive Committee of Education First, and is a trustee of The Mark and Kathie Miller Foundation. She is a member of the Utah Women's Forum, the International Women's Forum, and the Women's Leadership Council. She also serves as a mentor in the Mentor 2.0 program of Big Brothers Big Sisters of Utah.
